#### OFF-CAMPUS ONLINE COURSE AGREEMENT

- I understand that a student must have a 2.5 minimum overall GPA in order to enroll in an **off-campus** online course.
- I understand that the course(s) is taught completely online.
- I understand that the course(s) is taught by an online teacher, not taught by a Hartland High School staff member.
- I understand that a student cannot be successful in the course(s) unless they regularly log into the course(s) through the online provider.
- I understand that it is recommended that a student plan to spend a minimum of 1 hour per day per course on their online course(s).
- I understand that the student is responsible to communicate with their mentor on a regular basis as determined by the mentor & student.
- I understand that the student is required to attend lab time a minimum of once per week.

#### **PLEASE NOTE:**

- I understand that the student is <u>released from school</u> for the course(s) and will be <u>taking</u> this class at home. (beginning of the day and/or end of the day, depending on their schedule)
- I understand that the student will **NOT** be permitted in the building during this time.
- I understand that the student/parent is responsible for transportation to/from school.
- It is the parent's responsibility to monitor the student's progress in their online course.
- Final grade for the course will not be posted until the end of the semester.

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### REASONS WHY STUDENTS CAN BE DENIED

The district can deny a student's request to enroll in an online course for the following reasons:

- 1. The student has previously gained the credits provided from the completion of the online course.
- 2. The online course is not capable of generating academic credit.
- 3. The online course is inconsistent with the remaining graduation requirements or career interests of the student.
- 4. The student does not possess the prerequisite knowledge and skills to be successful in the online course or has demonstrated failure in previous online course.
- 5. The online course is of insufficient quality or rigor. The following courses are not approved by HHS due to insufficient quality or rigor:
  - Career Planning
  - Careers Find Your Future
  - Employability Skills
  - Leadership Skills
  - Personal Fitness
  - Reading for College Success
  - Social Media
  - Study Skills

## COURSE FAILURE AND CREDIT RECOVERY

- Students who have <u>failed</u> an online course will <u>not</u> be allowed to take an online course in the future.
- A student that has failed an online course may repeat the course at HHS or through HHS Credit Recovery or through HCS Summer School.
